

**Report on Operations and Accomplishments**  
2013 Operations and Accomplishments

On October 11, 2000, the Greater Rochester Sports Authority was empowered to operate and maintain a facility for the purpose of Minor League Baseball, presently known as Frontier Field.

2013 was successfully completed with close to 300,000 baseball fans attending Rochester Red Wings games at Frontier Field between April and September.

Frontier Field hosted many other non-baseball events including charity walks, concerts and Festivals.

In 2013, the Greater Rochester Sports Authority entered into two new agreements with Monroe County and Rochester Community Baseball effective January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013 to manage day-to-day operations and marketing for Frontier Field. Under the terms of these contracts, the County took over the day-to-day maintenance responsibilities to be reimbursed by the Authority while RCB took over all marketing activities to be paid at an annual fee of \$75,000. This new arrangement had a successful first year with all parties involved satisfied.
